

Japan Prayer Cards

Print the prayer cards on card stock or construction paper according to the color indicated. Cut them apart and laminate them for stability. The cards are color coded according to the type of prayer being offered. The colors are an important part of the activities. You will be using the cards throughout the Japan lessons for various prayer games and activities. Keep the cards all together in a ziplock bag between lessons.

6 green cards: Prayers of Thanksgiving (Help your students to be thankful for how God has created diversity of culture, races, and land forms, and yet He has openly revealed Himself through his creation so that man is without excuse. (Romans 1:20))

Thank God for the creative beauty the Japanese culture has brought to the world.

Thank God for the many different types of people he put on this earth.

Thank God for creating the Japanese islands to be part of our world.

Thank God for the witness of the Christians living in Japan.

Thank God for showing Himself to all people through His marvelous creation.

Thank God for giving you ears, eyes and a body to experience His creation and a mind to understand His Words.

6 red cards: Prayers of Action (Help your students to understand that although God does the work of bringing people to salvation through Jesus, we are responsible for using our lives, our actions and our words to introduce the people around us to Jesus.)

Pray that our Japanese EC churches would find creative ways to reach out to their communities.

Pray that American Christians would show Jesus' love to Japanese people living close to them.

Pray that God would show each of our Japanese pastors how to minister to their congregations.

Pray that God would use you and the students in your group to make a difference in the world.

Pray that God would give you new ideas every day about how to show God's love to all the people around you.

Pray that each Japanese Christian would be brave enough to worship only Jesus and never bow down to idols.

6 purple cards: Prayers of Request (Help your students to understand that when our desires are the same as God's desires, He honors and grants our requests.)

Pray that the hearts of the Japanese people would be open to the One True God.

Pray that our Japanese EC churches would be viewed with respect and interest by the people in their area.

Pray that Japanese people living all over the world would come to know Jesus as their Savior.

Pray that many more Evangelical Churches would be planted in Japan.

Pray that each of the children who attend the Sagami-hara Day Care Center would grow up to love Jesus.

Pray that Shintoists in Japan would continue to allow Christians to share their faith with others and worship as they choose.

6 yellow cards: Prayers of Protection (Help your students to know that although God allows difficulties, He is our Great Protector, and He cares about our well-being.)

Pray that God would protect the Japanese islands from disasters like tsunamis or earthquakes.

Pray that God would give safety and protection to the families of our EC pastors.

Pray that our EC church buildings would be protected from any harm.

Pray for God's protection over each of the families who worship in our Japanese EC churches.

Pray that God would grant health and energy to the Christians who are working to introduce Japan to Jesus.
