Today we'll learn a little about India. India is a country that is on the other side of our planet from us. This country is 8517 miles from the state of Pennsylvania! Whew – that's pretty far, don't you think? Think you could ride your bicycle to India from your house?



The country of India is bordered by the countries of Pakistan, China, Nepal, Bhutan, Bangladesh, and


Burma/Myanmar. It is also bordered by the Bay of Bengal on the east and the Arabian Sea on the west. The EC Church of India is located in the eastern most parts of India – do you see the red flag?



Let's take a look at the flag of India.

Saffron (orange) is on the top. It stands for courage and sacrifice. White is in the middle and represents peace, unity, and truth. Green is on the bottom and stands for faith and fertility.

In the center is a blue wheel with 24 spokes. This is the Dharma Chakra (or Wheel of Law). The symbol, or the "Chakra," is a symbol dating back to the 200th century BC, representing the many religious faiths in India.



Our Scripture for India is Matthew 11:28-30. Can you say it with me? There are many people in India who have never heard that Jesus loves them. He wants all to come to Him – even boys and girls like you who live in India! Let's continue to pray that people in India will put their trust in Jesus and accept Him into their hearts!




India has many different landscapes, just like the United States. There are mountains, rolling hills, deserts, beaches, and many beautiful buildings and green spaces – just like the next few pictures.






Like our Scripture passage reminds us -
