Robert is a native of St. Clair, PA, and attended Lebanon Valley College (1980-1984) where he earned a B.A. degree in history with certification in secondary education. He taught social studies at the Salzburg International Preparatory School in Salzburg, Austria (1984-88) before attending Evangelical School of Theology (1988-1992) where he earned a M.Div. degree. After serving on the pastoral staff at Palmyra First E.C. Church and as pastor of Harrisburg Faith E.C. Church, he moved to New York City (1995) to be part of L.I.F.E. (Living in Freedom Eternally) Ministry. Since moving to NYC, he has served as director of a senior center and supervisor of a ground crew at LaGuardia Airport. He currently serves as a part-time counselor at L.I.F.E. Ministry and temporary supply pastor of the United Presbyterian Church in St. Clair, PA.
